HUNTER, COUNTRY ENGLISH & WESTERN PLEASURE

In Hunter Pleasure, horses may show with braided mane and/or tail and no Country English Pleasure attire or tack is allowed. In Country English, no Hunt attire or tack is allowed. Hunter or Country English Pleasure horses may cross enter classes, but points will be counted separate toward EITHER the Hunt or Country English Year End High point award. Both styles of riding may cross enter Western, but those points will also be counted separately toward the Western Overall High point award. IN OTHER WORDS A HALTER CLASS AND A MAXIMUM OF FOUR PERFORMANCE CLASSES OF THE SAME DISCIPLINE COUNT FOR OVERALL AWARD: THE JUNIOR OVERALL AWARD IS THE SAME PLUS THE SHOWMANSHIP CLASS. Only one buckle will be awarded to horse and rider combination per year.

YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP

This class demonstrates the exhibitor's ability to fit, prepare and show a horse at halter. Hu exhibitors may show horses in braided mane and tail. To be judged 60% on handler's showmanship 40% on presentation (condition, grooming, tack and neatness of attire). **Stallions are prohibited** this class. This class is included toward your Junior overall high points.

LEADLINE

This class is open to children between the ages of 3 and 10. Show attire required. **Child must wear helmet and horse must be lead by an Adult.**

WALK TROT PLEASURE/WALK TROT EQUITATION

These classes are open to children 10 and under. If the Walk/Trot competitor moves to any class requiring a lope or canter during the circuit year, that competitor forfeits all Walk/Trot points.

WALK/TROT 11 THRU ADULT & NOVICE RIDER

The Walk/Trot class is for any child or amateur adult who is just beginning to ride. **No cross entry and No Green horses please.** The Novice class is for anyone who has not won three first place ribbons at any show in that discipline. Open to both PB and half Arabians, western, hunter pl. or country english pl. THIS CLASS WILL NOT HAVE A CLASS HIGH POINT AWARD, NO COUNT TOWARD THE OVERALL HIGH POINT.

FIRST AND SECOND YEAR PLEASURE, OPEN

This class is for any age horse in his first or second year of showing, to be judged on attitude, manners, performance and quality. All horses must be in an appropriate bridle and bit. Junior western horses (5 and under) not in the bridle, must follow USEF rules. THIS CLASS WILL NOT HAVE A HIGH POINT AWARD, NOR WILL POINTS COUNT TOWARD THE OVERALL HIGH POINT

LIBERTY

The Liberty class will be open to the first ten horses entered. Two minutes will be allowed in the ring. No more than two handlers with standard show whips will be allowed. No noise making devices are allowed. Owners may supply a cassette tape or CD, set to the appropriate music and labeled with the name of both horse and owner. Any informational material must be typed or very clearly printed so the announcer can read. Judge may disqualify your horse if it is not caught within one and a half minutes allowed time. **Appropriate show attire (see below) is to be worn by both handler** The Judge will judge this class. **Stallions are prohibited. Horses need to be 3 and over to enter this class.**

STALLIONS

Arabian & ½ Arabian stallions may be shown by men, ladies and juniors in all classes open to stallions.

ATTIRE

Chaps and Coats are optional, all other appropriate show clothing is required in all classes, ie hats, helmets, long sleeve shirts, long pants, jodpurs and boots etc.
